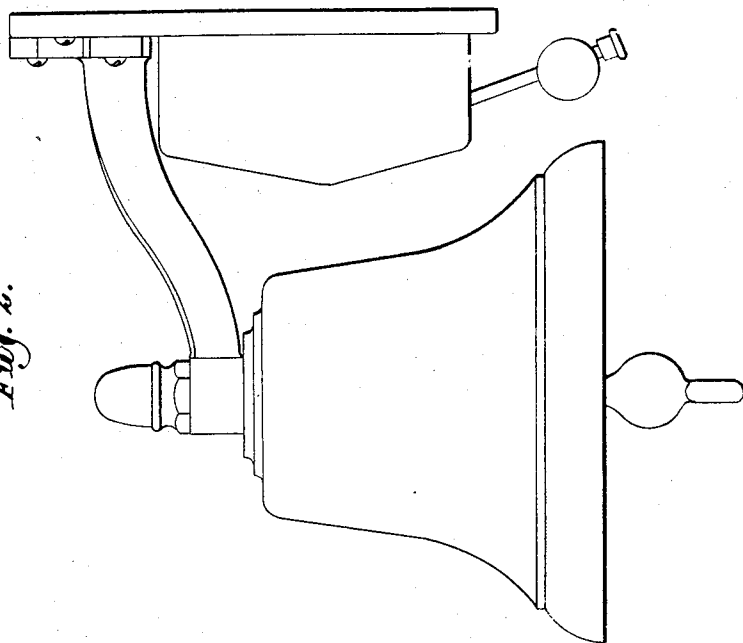

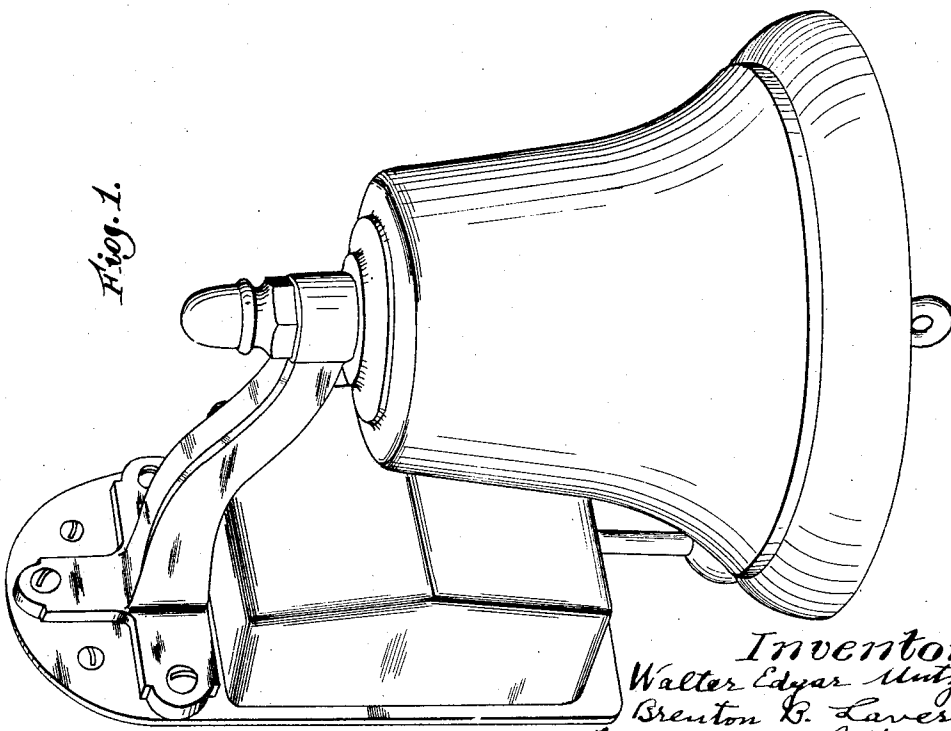

DESIGN FOR A COMBINED SHIP BELL AND STRIKING UNIT

Application filed May 29, 1930. Serial No. 35,857. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that we, WALTER E. MUTZ of Roslindale, in the county of Suffolk, in the State of Massachusetts and BRENTON B. LAVERS, of Medford, Massachusetts, in the county of Middlesex, and both citizens of the United States, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for combined Ship Bell and Striking Unit, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.
